HOMEWORK


Homework: Spellings and homework given on a Friday to be handed in Wednesday.

ENGLISH ACTIVITIES

During this half term the children will be:

- Researching information about Roald Dahl and his books
- Writing using the correct tense and using paragraphs
- Writing using speech marks and 'wow' words
- Writing instructions, character descriptions, poems and book reviews
- Reading and performing plays
- Continuing to read in groups at school through guided and shared reading sessions.

MATHEMATICS ACTIVITIES

The children will practise times tables and mental skills every day. Other Maths activities for this half-term will include:

- Adding and subtracting numbers with up to 3 digits
- Measuring, writing and reading the time in 5 minute intervals
- Recognising, describing and make 2d/3d shapes
- Fractions of shapes and numbers
- Solving number and word problems
- Recognising the place value of a digit
- Statistics: Pictograms and tables

SCIENCE ACTIVITIES

Children will learn about Forces and Magnets, including thinking scientifically and investigating how objects need forces to make them move, how different surfaces effect movement and how magnets work including how to test them.

GEOGRAPHY ACTIVITIES

During this half-term the children will be studying maps and identifying different counties, countries and cities of the U.K. They will also be locating geographical features such as rivers and mountain ranges and discussing why people live in various places.

HISTORY ACTIVITIES

The children will be class detectives to solve the 'History Mystery'. An event has occurred in class and it's up to them to solve what period in time it has come from! We will also focus on chronology and the children's understanding of time. Including a trip linked to our topic.

ART AND DESIGN
