## Science

The topics for this term are Forces, Living things and their Habitats. We will be looking closely at the forces at work in our planet, including gravity and air resistance. We will also be looking at animal classification and life cycles in the second half of this term.

Due to the changes in the testing procedures, we will also be doing a big push on written methods.
