## Key Stage One - Homework explained

As stated in the school's homework policy, children in Year 2 should receive the entitlement of 1 hour homework per week.

I will give children homework on a Friday to be returned on a Wednesday. Work should be completed as neat as possible and in pencil as it will be marked when returned to school.

Year 2 children are to remember their reading books, reading records, blue homework book and spelling pots.

Homework in class 3 may include: -

- A simple writing or maths task in their blue homework book, this task should take between 15-30 minutes. The task will always be explained to your child and will consolidate their learning in class.
- Where possible, I will try to include practical activities and ideas at home.
  Children who put a special effort into their homework can have their work displayed on our 'Wall of Fame'.
- · Weekly spellings.
- Sometimes, I may need to send spellings home to practise in their spelling pots. This should only take a couple of minutes each night to revisit the spellings (a separate guide to spellings has been provided).
- Reading books children must read at least once per week. A shorter session but as often as possible would be more beneficial than reading a whole book in one sitting. Children who read often can move along the challenge to become a 'Reading Master'.
