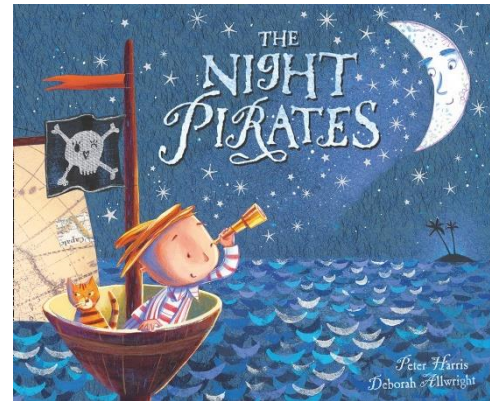
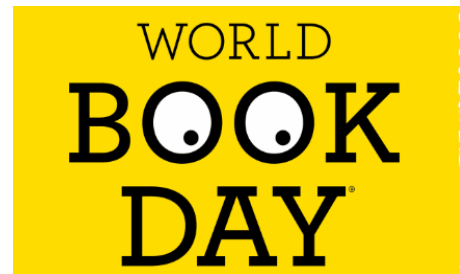
Children are also invited to bring to school, any books in good condition, that they no longer want. We will be holding a book swap as part of the day's activities.
