Curriculum Coverage

Writing

Maths

- Place Value (Y5 & Y6)

Each day the children will complete daily arithmetic questions as well as a daily speed table in order to help them remember and become more fluent when using essential key facts. Each week they will also complete an arithmetic test.

English



Our key reading texts for this term are Impossible creatures as our whole class text and The Boy at the Back of the Class which we will be using to inspire our English writing tasks in the first half term. We will be exploring and a range of writing genres over the term, both fiction and non fiction.

Grammar and Punctuation

Grammar and punctuation are a key requirement for all primary age children and therefore is threaded throughout all lessons.

Reading

Weekly comprehension exercises and group and whole class guided reading sessions will continue to develop comprehension skills.

Reading is essential to your child's learning. Please encourage your child to read for at least 10 minutes each day at home.

History - Anglo Saxon and Vikings

This term, we will be learning all about who the Anglo Saxons were and why they invaded Britain and settled there. They will understand how Christianity arrived in England and the significance of certain individuals and places of heritage.

Pupils will discover that many changes took place in the North East of England for the Anglo Saxons during their time.

Geography - Settle Down

Your child will have an understanding of what the word 'settlement' means and be able to identify different types of settlements, commenting on the physical and human features of each.

They will be able to compare how settlements looked in the past with how they look in the present day using a range of sources including maps, diagrams and aerial photographs.

Science

Our first unit this term is Forces. Your children will consolidate and extend their knowledge of forces by naming individual forces (e.g. gravity, friction, upthrust). They will extend their knowledge of frictional forces (air resistance and water resistance) and plan fair test investigations to discover which shoe has the greatest friction and which shapes offer the most water resistance.

Our second unit of work is Properties of Materials. During this unit of work, children will consolidate previous learning by revisiting the properties of solids, liquids and gases; learn to describe the properties of materials using scientific language; investigate which materials make the best thermal insulators; and which materials are magnetic.
